LANGUAGE – STUDY – REGIONAL STUDIES

Our intensive course will provide you with everything you need for your studies at the UAS in Zwickau.

GERMAN COURSE – PROGRAMME

CONTENTS

The course comprises of 120 teaching hours and self-instructed study. At the end of the course there will be a final test. You will receive a certificate of attendance or a certificate and 6 CPs.

PROJECT WORK

During the course we will work in projects that focus on a specific topic (cf. examples below). Each group will prepare a presentation from its research work on the final project day:

- (1) Project group Life in Germany
- (2) Project group Language & Writing
- (3) Project group Places of Remembrance
- (4) Project group Music & Songs in Germany
- (5) Project group Inventors & Inventions
- (6) Project group Saxony & the World

WORKSHOPS

The course programme is complemented by workshops in which you apply the German language through work and play, while dancing, singing and enjoying activities. The following workshops will be provided: Film/Video, Theatre as well as Dance.

You can also take advantage of a TANDEM-learning duo to improve your language skills. Moreover, we offer extensive German language courses during the term and preparatory training for TestDaF.
